

**AMATEUR FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT
ORLEN OLYMPICS 2019
TERMS & CONDITIONS
(hereinafter: "Regulations")**

§1

General rules

1. These Regulations define the conditions and rules for conducting an amateur football tournament held on June 8, 2019 on the Wisła Płock training football pitches at 34 Łukasiewicza Street in Płock (hereinafter: "**Competition**" or "**Tournament**") as part of ORLEN OLYMPICS 2019.
2. The purpose of the Competition is to integrate around universal values and to promote the image of PKN ORLEN S.A.
3. The organizer of the competition is MyPlace Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Warsaw at 42 Młynarska Street, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register maintained by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, 12th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under the number KRS 0000274560, NIP number: 701005450, REGON: 140858208, with the share capital of 300 000,00 PLN (hereinafter: "**Organizer**").
4. The rules of the course and participation in ORLEN OLYMPICS 2019 are set out in the ORLEN OLYMPICS 2019 Terms & Conditions (hereinafter: "**Event Regulations**") available on the website www.olimpiada.orlen.pl (hereinafter: "**Website**").

§2

Personal data

1. Administrator of personal data of Competition Participants within the meaning of Regulation of European Parliament and Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation - hereinafter "**GDPR**") is Polski Koncern Naftowy ORLEN Spółka Akcyjna, with its registered office in Płock 09-411, at 7 Chemików Street (hereinafter "**Administrator**" or "**PKN ORLEN S.A.**"). Contact telephone numbers: (24) 256 00 00, (24) 365 00 00, (22) 778 00 00.
2. For contact with the Data Protection Supervisor in PKN ORLEN S.A. the following e-mail address is used: daneosobowe@orlen.pl.
3. Personal data of Participants are processed:
 - a) in accordance with Article 6(1a) of GDPR - in order to participate in the Competition, for which the Participant has agreed, including the consolidation of its course, image, sending organizational information (email / SMS), handling notifications and complaints;
 - b) in accordance with Article 6(1c) of GDPR - in order to fulfil legal obligations incumbent on the Administrator, in particular in the tax, accounting and obligated institutions;
 - c) in accordance with Article 6(1f) of GDPR - for legitimate interests pursued by the Administrator, i.e. direct marketing of own products and services, as well as investigation and defence in the event of mutual claims.
4. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the Competition in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations. Refusal to provide personal data is tantamount to the lack of the possibility of joining and participating in the Competition.
5. The Participant's personal details may be disclosed by PKN ORLEN S.A. to entities it cooperates with, in particular entities cooperating in the implementation of the Competition and related actions and entities providing postal or courier, accounting and bookkeeping, legal, debt collection and archiving services.
6. Personal data are processed for the period necessary to conduct the Competition and after their completion for the period required by law and until the mutual claims expire. If consent is granted, personal data will be processed until it is withdrawn.
7. Rights in connection with the processing of personal data:
 - access to the content of one's personal data, it's amendment (correcting, supplementing, e.g. when it is incorrect or incomplete),

- removing or limiting the processing of personal data,
- transfer of data to another administrator, i.e. the right to receive from PKN ORLEN S.A. personal data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable information format. The participant may send this data to another data administrator or request PKN ORLEN S.A. to send data to another administrator. However, PKN ORLEN S.A. will do this only if such sending is technically possible. The right to transfer personal data is only valid for such data processed under the contract,
- raising objections - in cases when PKN ORLEN S.A. processes personal data based on one's legitimate interest,
- the right to withdraw consent - the consent may be withdrawn at any time. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the legality of the processing which was carried out on its basis.

In the event of exercising one of the rights, the Administrator will make every effort and take the necessary actions to implement them.

8. Every person whose personal data the Administrator processes, has the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory body, which is the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.

§3

Participation in the competition

1. Competition Participants may only be employees of PKN ORLEN S.A. and companies belonging to the ORLEN Capital Group. Employee within the meaning of the Regulations should be understood as a person employed by PKN ORLEN S.A. or in another company of the ORLEN Capital Group based on a contract of employment. Participants who are employees of the Organizer and persons not employed under an employment contract but who cooperate with the Organizer on the basis of a civil law agreement are excluded from participation in the Competition.
2. Participants in the meaning of the Regulations should be understood as a person who meets the conditions set out in the Regulations and participates in the Competition (hereinafter: "**Participant**").
3. Participants are required to show the Organizer the document confirming the identity in the Competition Office before the start of the Competition (on the days indicated in paragraph 6 below). A person who does not show the above-mentioned document cannot participate in the Competition.
4. Participants are required to comply with the Event Regulations, public order, orders of the organizers and respect for other Participants and attendees of ORLEN OLYMPICS 2019. The Organizer has the right to remove from the Competition persons who in any way violate the provisions of the Regulations.
5. Each Participant is obliged to submit - together with the application form referred to in §7(2.2) of the Regulations - a written statement (according to the pattern indicated in Annex No. 1 to the Regulations) or in the case of persons registering via the registration panel available on the Website in accordance with the provisions of § 7(2.1) of the Regulations, in the form of deselecting (accepting) the appropriate checkbox, by confirming that the Participant:
 - accepts the Regulations and undertakes to comply with them;
 - has good health enabling him to participate in the Competition (in particular without medical contraindications to participate in the Competition) and that he agrees to participate in the Competition only on his own responsibility with full awareness of the dangers and risks arising from the nature of the event;
 - consents to the processing of personal data for purposes related to the organization of ORLEN OLYMPICS 2019 and Competitions;
 - consents to the use, including free distribution by PKN ORLEN of S.A. and the Organizer of his image captured on photographs and film materials made during the Competition and ORLEN OLYMPICS 2019;
 - agrees to undergo verification at the Race Office on the dates indicated in paragraph 6 below. During the verification it will be necessary for the Participant to submit again a written statement referred to in sub-paragraph. b above.

6. Each of the Competition Participants will receive a starter pack consisting of a bag, t-shirt, and drink (hereinafter: "**Starter Package**"). In order to collect Starter Packages Participants can apply to the competition office located in the ORLEN Arena car park, 1 Plac Celebry Papieskiej in Płock (hereinafter: "**Competition Office**") in the following days and hours:
 - a) June 7, 2019, between 7:00 and 22:00, and
 - b) June 8, 2019, from 7:00 am to the end of the Competition.

§4

Tournament rules

1. Team teams, including names of Participants, team name and company name will be published on the Website no later than 5 (five) days before the Tournament.
2. The start time of the Tournament will be announced on the Website by May 31, 2019.
3. The Tournament may be attended by persons correctly registered and registered in accordance with the Regulations. All Participants are obliged to wear a sports outfit, provided by Participants on their own. Participants entered into the Tournament may not take part in the 2018/2019 season in competitions organized by the Polish Football Association and District Football Unions except for district leagues (fifth division in Poland) and lower leagues.
4. The Tournament starts on the Wisła Płock football pitches at 34 Łukasiewicza Street in Płock in accordance with the designation on the map of ORLEN OLIMPIADA 2019, which is available on the Website and in the Tournament Office.
5. Within 2 (two) days from the date of publication of the teams' teams referred to in paragraph 1 above, team captains may submit in writing possible protests regarding Participants of the opposing team. The protest must be indicated by the first and last name of the person the protest concerns and the precisely formulated object of the protest. After this time, all protests will not be accepted.
6. Protests referred to in para. 5 above, must be submitted via e-mail to olimpiada@orlen.pl.
7. The Organizer, after receiving the protest, will immediately notify the captain of the team whose composition the protest concerns about the protest and then take appropriate steps to clarify the situation.
8. The captain of the team, to which the protest refers, within 2 (two) days from the date of receipt of information about the protest is obliged to provide the Organizer with appropriate explanations (by e-mail). In the absence of an explanation by the captain of the team concerned by the protest, the Organizer has the right to disqualify the Participant or team from participating in the Tournament without taking preliminary explanatory steps.
9. Participants of the Tournament, immediately after the match taking place as part of the Tournament, may submit protests that will concern matters that arose during the match. The protests referred to in the previous sentence should be brought to the main judge (hereinafter: the "Central Judge"). The Main Judge issues the final opinion immediately after the match. If the Participant does not agree with the final decision of the Chief Judge, he may complete the protest form, which will be available in the Tournament Office and will be considered by 13.06.2019. The participant will be informed about the consideration of the protest submitted in the mode indicated in the preceding sentence by electronic correspondence to the e-mail address indicated in the protest form.
10. The draw, the subject of which will be to determine the teams' position will be carried out by May 31, 2019. The results of the draw will be published on the Website.
11. In the case of submitting teams in the number greater than 32 (thirty two), the Organizer reserves the right to organize previous elimination, which will inform all Participants.
12. Matches held as part of the Tournament are played according to the rules of the game of football.
13. The team consists of 5 (five) participants in the field and goalkeeper (6 people in total).
14. It is allowed to use shoes like lances by competitors. It is forbidden to use shoes with screw corks.
15. It is forbidden to play sliding.
16. The team must start the match in full composition, however, the end of the match may be composed of a minimum of four (four) players entitled to play. In the absence of a minimum number of players, the bye is dictated.

17. For the duration of the match, participants will receive markers (vests) to distinguish teams, goalkeepers will be marked with a different colour of the outfit.
18. Playing time: 2 x 10 minutes with a break to change sides.
19. The matches will be played on the pitch of $\frac{1}{4}$ football pitch - similar to the so-called polish "Orlik".
20. Gates dimensions: 2 x 5 m.
21. When throwing a car, a cornering or a free-throw, the distance of the defending players is at least 3 (three) meters from the ball.
22. The throw from the car is performed with the foot from the place where the ball exits the pitch, the ball must stand still, it cannot be scored directly.
23. Resuming the game after the goal is always from the centre of the court, after the referee's whistle.
24. The goalkeeper may enter the ball with both the hand and the leg.
25. Each team is entitled to make any number of changes of Participants staying on the pitch. Participants' changes take place in the hockey system, in the change zone - first the participant leaves the playing field and then enters his alternate.
26. The offside regulation does not apply.
27. After passing the ball through the partner to his own goalkeeper, he can not take over (except for the head, chest, belly).
28. Goalkeeper can score a goal, but not a direct throw.
29. A penalty kick is made from a distance of 9 meters.
30. In the group stage matches, 3 points are awarded for the match, 1 point for the draw and 0 points for the failure.
31. A draw result is allowed in the group stage matches, in matches in subsequent rounds, in the event of a tie, the judge orders a penalty shootout competition (3 penalties, then one for effect). The participant may shoot a penalty for the second time only when all Participants from his team give up their shot. Participants who were substitutes at the end of the match do not shoot criminal.
32. The planned way and schedule of matches to be held during the Tournament will be posted on the Website until 6.06.2019.
33. In the group stage matches in the event of disqualification of any of the teams, for the opposing teams that played matches against the team, a 3: 0 walkover will be awarded.
34. The winners of the Tournament (hereinafter: "**Winners**") are 3 (three) men's teams and 3 (three) women's teams.
35. The matches are conducted by the judges appointed by the Organizer.
36. Matches take place according to the schedule. The team that is not ready to play when the match starts is disqualified.
37. The following rewards are provided for the winners (hereinafter: "Awards"):
 - a) for the 1st place (separate classification of men and women) the prize of PLN 300.00 (in words: three hundred zlotys) for each member of the winning team;
 - b) for the second place (separate classification of men and women) the prize of PLN 200.00 (in words: two hundred zlotys) for each member of the winning team;
 - c) for the third place (separate classification of men and women), a prize worth PLN 100.00 (in words: one hundred zlotys) for each member of the winning team.
38. The official announcement of the results of the Tournament and the indication of the Winners will take place immediately after the end of the Tournament on the electronic scoreboard.
39. Prizes will be awarded to the Winners on the day of the Competition.
40. Undistributed Awards remain at the disposal of the Organizer.
41. The transfer of the right to the Reward by the Winner to third parties or its exchange for a monetary equivalent or another type of prize is not possible.
42. Winners shall not be entitled to reserve the special features of the Prize or to exchange it for another item.

§5 Sport behaviour

1. For offenses in the game or unsportsmanlike conduct, the referee may punish the

Participant with a yellow or red card. The first yellow card is a reprimand. The participant receives a red card for the second yellow card and must leave the pitch. The red card is a penalty for the participant for the entire match, - without consequences for next matches.

2. A player may be excluded from participation in the match and the Tournament for:
 - a) deliberate kicking, striking or attempting to strike an opponent;
 - b) attack the opponent in a brutal way;
 - c) breaking the ball towards the empty goal with the hand;
 - d) use of abusive or vulgar words in relation to a judge or players, expression by a gesture or word of dissatisfaction with a judge's decision;
 - e) violation of the bodily immunity of the judge;
 - f) other behaviour which the judge considers grossly unsportsmanlike;
 - g) other violation of these Regulations,
3. Only the judge is authorized to interpret and evaluate the behaviour of the Participant.

§ 6 Healthcare

1. The Organizer is obliged to insure all Participants taking part in the Competition against accident.
2. The Organizer provides first medical assistance for injuries occurring during the Competition. However, it does not bear any responsibility for participation in the Occupations of sick persons (any deviation from the full health of the body) and resulting accidents and their consequences.

§ 7 Applications

1. Applications for participation in the Competition are accepted from May 15, 2019 to May 24, 2019 (hereinafter: "**Applications**").
2. Applications can be made:
 - 1) by completing the electronic registration form available on the Website in the "Documents" tab in a manner consistent with the instructions or
 - 2) by completing the paper registration form, available on the Website and delivering it - along with the statement, the specimen of which constitutes Annex No. 1 to the Regulations:
 - a) by post to the following address: PKN ORLEN S.A., Sports Marketing, Sponsorship and Events Office, 09-411 Płock, 7 Chemików Street, with the note ORLEN OLYMPICS 2019;
 - b) personally to PKN ORLEN S.A. in Płock, 7 Chemików Street, building 07, room 808;
 - c) in the form of an electronic scan to the following e-mail address: olimpiada@orlen.pl;
3. Applications made in a different way than indicated in paragraph 2 above, the Organizer will leave without consideration.
4. Participation in the Competition is free and available for a limited number of Participants.

§8 Complaints

1. Any complaints regarding the course or organization of the Competition may be submitted to the Organizer in the form of electronic correspondence sent to the following e-mail address: olimpiada@myplace.com.pl
2. The complaint referred to in paragraph 1 above, should enable identification of the person submitting it, in order to inform her about the complaint consideration. For this purpose, the person lodging the complaint may indicate, for example: the name and surname, delivery address, and also include in the complaint a description of the incident to which it relates.
3. Complaints may be submitted by June 15, 2019.

4. The person submitting the complaint will be notified by the Organizer of the manner of handling the complaint within a maximum of 14 (fourteen) days from the date of receipt of the complaint, in accordance with the contact details indicated in paragraph. 2 above.

§ 9
Final Provisions

1. The Regulations are available on the Website and at the Organizer's office.
2. In matters not covered by the Regulations, the provisions of the Regulations of the Event and the generally applicable provisions of law, including the Civil Code, shall apply.
3. In matters relating to Competitions not regulated in the Regulations and the Regulations of the Event, the final decision is made by the Organizer.
4. The Organizer is entitled to change these Regulations. The Organizer will inform the Participants of any change in the Regulations by posting the relevant information on the Website and at the Organizer's office.
